How to Use your Appointment Calendar

There are three class contact methods during COVID: Self-paced web lessons can be completed @ [texaswic.org](https://www.texaswic.org). Live web lessons requiring pre-registration can be completed also at [texaswic.org](https://www.texaswic.org). Pre-recorded cooking classes may be viewed on our Facebook page @ [Abilene-Taylor County WIC Program](https://www.facebook.com/Abilene-Taylor-County-WIC-Program). Your WIC enrollment status will determine the online class you attend. There are live online classes offered for every enrollment category. Again, you must pre-register for live discussion classes. Self-paced online classes offer enrollment specific options @ [texaswic.org](https://www.texaswic.org). Please visit [texaswic.org](https://www.texaswic.org) to complete the appropriate class for your enrollment category. To receive class credit and benefit issuance, upload your class certificate in the gateway portal, drop your WIC card off in the mailboxes located at the entrance doors, at the Public Health Building. Your card will be reloaded and mailed back to you at the address we have on file. You will receive your WIC card & shopping list in the mail with-in 1-2 business days. Screenings (SCN) during COVID

Once a year children under 5 years of age, are required to have a screening to continue receiving WIC benefits. We will schedule your next appointment each time we load benefits (**appointments given on availability**). All screenings will be done over the phone during the COVID pandemic.

What to Provide for the appointment:

1. Proof of Identification (WIC card, social security card, shot record, birth certificate). Call the office if you have questions.
2. Proof of Address (cannot be WIC mail, personal or P.O. Box)
3. Proof of Income (within the last 30 days) or Current Active Medicaid Card
