Update: 50-year-old Scotty Wilson was arrested this morning at an apartment complex located in the 1700 Block of N. 6th St. He is the final suspect wanted in connection to the Aggravated Kidnapping of Priscilla Limon.

Update: 34-year-old Ashley Alaniz was arrested by police on Friday, May 28, 2021. APD Street Cimes arrested her at a duplex located in the 3900 blk. of Lynwood Drive. Also arrested, was 67-year-old Ricky Anderson for Hindering Apprehension. Both will be transported to the Taylor County Jail. Roger Wison is still outstanding.

APD Arrest Two Suspects for Aggravated Kidnapping and Searching for Two Others

ABILENE, TX – The Abilene Police Department Criminal Investigations Division arrested two Abilene men and is looking for an Abilene woman and female for the aggravated kidnapping of 38-year-old Priscilla Limon, who was found deceased in the Clear Fork of the Brazos, on May 5, by foul play.

On Friday, May 21, George Edward Harry Frosch (45 yoa), Blake Andrew Britner (32 yoa), were arrested and charged with First Degree Felony Aggravated Kidnapping. Roger Scotty Wilson (50 yoa), and Ashley Alaniz (34 yoa), remain outstanding. An extensive investigation revealed the four played a part in the abduction of Limon.

Frosch and Britner are being held in the Taylor County Jail. The investigation is ongoing and other charges are possible.
