Aggravated Assault 600 Sycamore

ABILENE, TX – On Friday, 10-15-2021 at approximately 9:32 a.m. Abilene Police responded to the scene of a shooting in the 600 block of Sycamore. Witnesses advised a 29-year-old Hispanic male had shot a 60-year-old white male. The identity of the victim has not yet been released and his condition is listed as stable. The suspect fled the scene into a nearby residence, according to witnesses.

Patrol units responded, set a perimeter, and attempted to make contact with the suspect. The SWAT team responded, continued to try to contact the suspect via loudspeaker and telephone.

Investigators applied for and received both a search and arrest warrant for the suspect, who was identified as Seth Adam Blake. A parole warrant is currently active for the suspect. After several hours on scene, gas was deployed into the residence. The SWAT team made entry into the residence after exhausting all other means of communication with Blake. Blake was not located in the residence.

Blake is wanted for Violation of Parole and Second Degree Felony Aggravated Assault. If anyone has information regarding this investigation, please contact the Abilene Police Department’s non-emergency number at 673-8331 or Abilene Crime Stoppers at 676-(TIPS).

UPDATE: On Saturday, 10-16-2021 at approximately 3:30 a.m. Seth Blake was taken into custody without incident at a north side hotel. Blake is being charged with Violation of Parole (no bond) and Second Degree Felony Aggravated Assault (\$400,000 bond). Blake will be booked into the Taylor County Detention Center.
