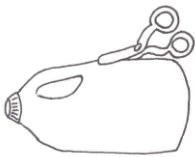

PAPER PLATE PIG

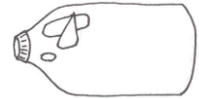
Use 1 small plate for head and 1 large plate to make pig.
Decorate with scraps



PIGGY BANK



1. Cut a slit in the top of an empty bleach bottle.
2. Cut eyes and ears from scraps and glue onto pig.
3. Add corks for feet.
4. Poke hole in back and insert curled pipe cleaner for tail.

GAMES

PIN THE TAIL ON THE PIGGY

Make a large picture of a pig with tail missing. Put the picture on a wall or a door. Make pig tail from curled pipe cleaner. Attach a piece of tape onto the pig's tail. Blindfold child and let him try to put the tail on the piggy.

PIG TAILS

Give each child a pink streamer which will be his pig tail. Have him tuck one end of the streamer into the back of his pants or tie a scarf around his waist to tuck the streamer into. The object of the games is to catch each other's pig tails. Have the children get down on their hands and knees. The children must keep two knees and at least one hand on the floor at all times. "Pigs" who lose their tails may return to the teacher for another tail. Play until the children tire of game. It is not necessary to count how many tails each child has caught. There does not need to be one winner. The purpose of the game is to have fun.

OTHER FUN STUFF

POEM

Recite "This Little Piggy" and play with toes!

PIG WALK

Pigs have no knees. They walk with stiff legs. Have the children try to walk without bending their knees. Ask, "Is it hard to do?" Have them try to walk up and down a couple of stairs. (Make sure they hold on!)

KEEPING COOL

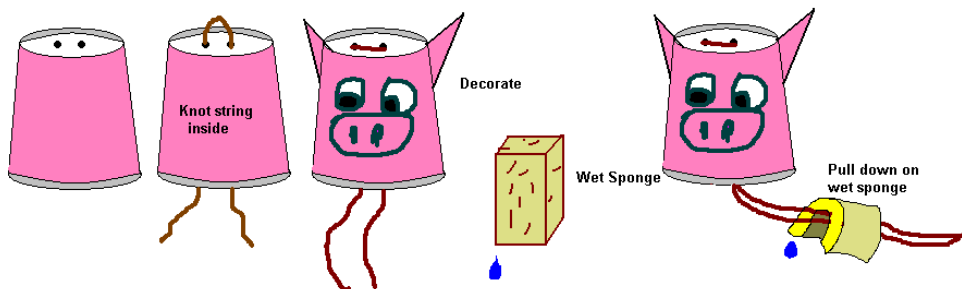
Pigs don't sweat so they can't keep cool like humans do. They often use mud to help them stay cool. Place some mud in a large plastic tub. Have the children dip their hands and arms into it. Talk about how the mud keeps the pigs cool. Ask, "Does it feel cool on your hands and arms?" This can be done outside.

PIG NOSES

Cut circle from poster board. Draw on 2 nostrils. Attach string to opposite sides of pig nose. Tie on to face!

SQUEALING PIGGY

1. Poke 2 holes in bottom of cup.
2. Loop 2 foot length of string through holes and knot on inside of cup.
3. Decorate cup like pig.
4. Wet a small sponge. Wrap it around the string and pull down firmly. The friction on the string will make a grunting sound. Experiment with the sounds.

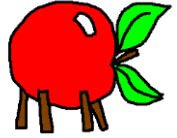


SNACK

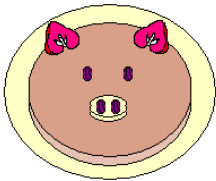
APPLE PIGS



1. Use 1 large apple and 1 small. Push 4 toothpicks into large apple to make legs.
2. Cut approximately 1/4 of small apple off to make flat surface for face. Use craft stick or several toothpicks to attach head to body.
3. Use cloves for nostrils and eyes. Use almond slivers for ears.



PANCAKE PIG



1. Tint pancake batter with a few drops of red food coloring.
2. Cook a small, round pancake for each child.
3. Add 2 strawberry halves for ears, 2 raisins for eyes, a banana slice for a snout, and 2 more raisins for nostrils. Add strawberry syrup smile, if desired.

PIGS IN A BLANKET

1 Pkg. cocktail sausage

1 can crescent rolls

Unroll crescent rolls and cut into 1 equal triangles. Roll one sausage into each triangle. Place 2" apart on cookie sheet and bake according to can directions.

GRAIN IN A TROUGH

Prepare trail mix by mixing together raisins, oat cereal, nuts, cheese crackers, and popcorn. Serve in small boxes that resemble miniature troughs.

FIG SLOP

Combine chocolate pudding with M&M's, nuts, raisins, coconut, cereal, Candy sprinkles, chopped apples and bananas!

PIGS IN MUD

Need: Pink Mini Marshmallows, Chocolate Pudding Mix

Directions: Make the pudding according to the package directions. Place the pudding into clear cups. Drop pink mini marshmallows on top. Make sure they don't sink. Refrigerate. After the pudding has set you can serve the "Pigs in mud"

EIGHT PIGS

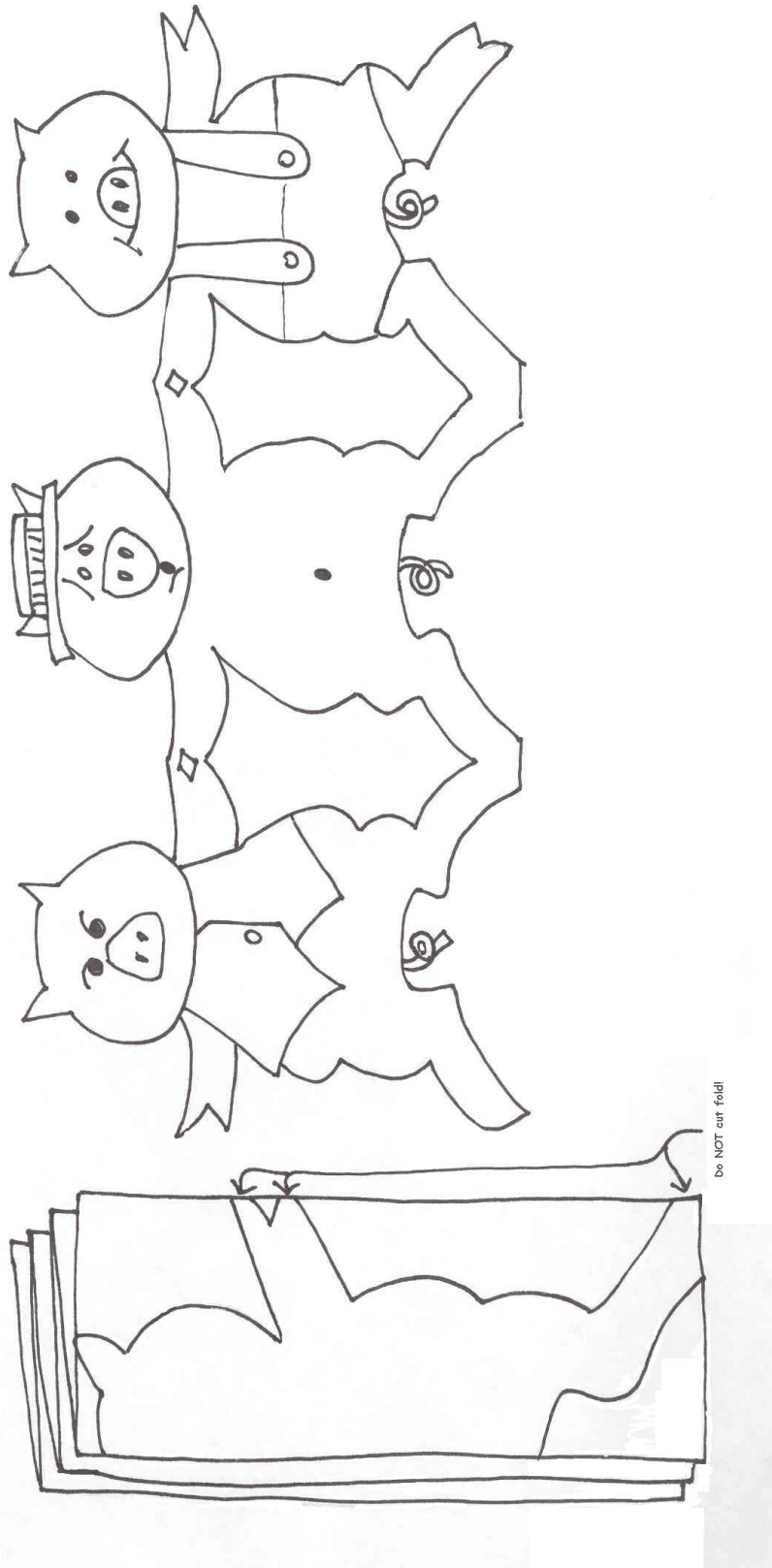
2 mother pigs lived in a pen (hold up thumbs)

With lots of yummy piggy slop! (rub belly!)

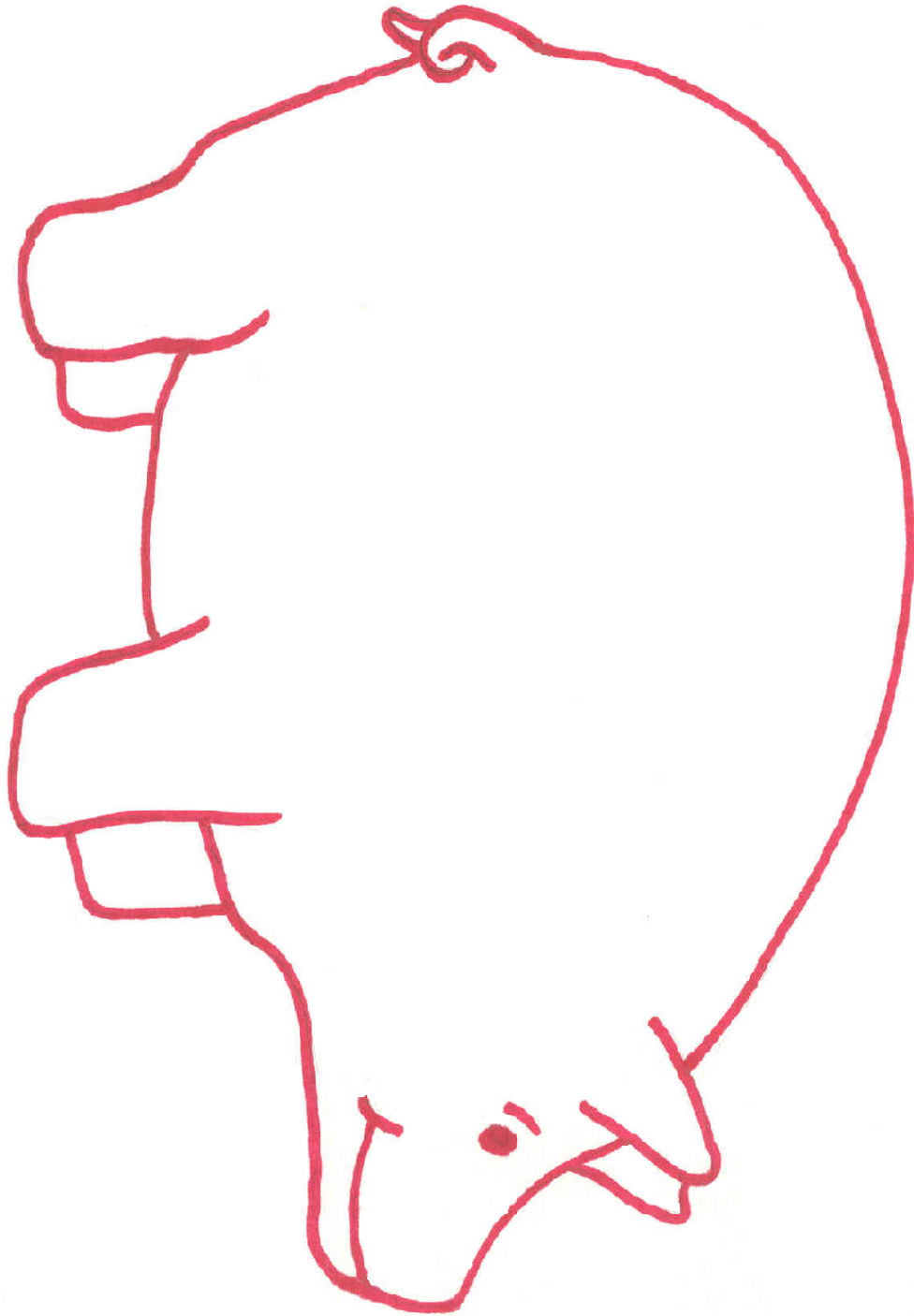
PIG CHAIN

Fold paper in accordion folds. Draw 1/2 of pig on fold and cut. (make sure to leave folds in tact) Open up to make pig chain. Color and decorate pigs.



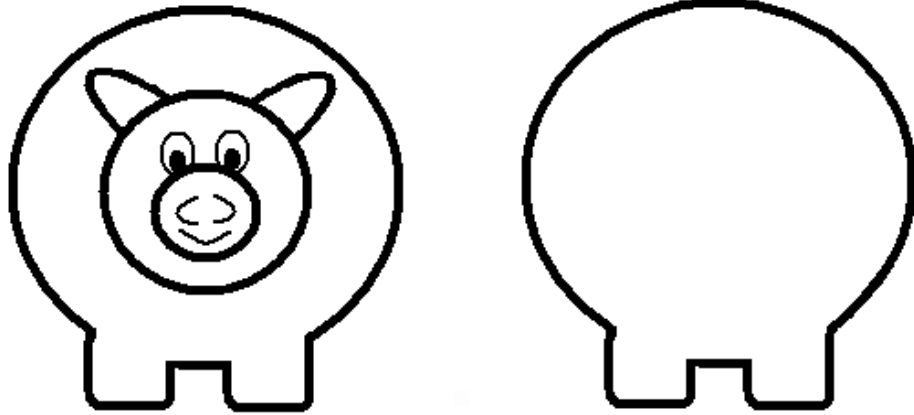
PIGS IN THE MUD

Spray work surface with water, lay paper down, and wipe paper with wet sponge. (this helps paper stick to table.) Place a spoonful of chocolate pudding (or brown finger paint) in middle of paper. Allow children to finger-paint with pudding. After smushing "mud" around, let children place pigs on paper.



SPOOL PIG

Cut out pig patterns. Color. Glue each half to opposite ends of a spool. Add a short piece of curled ribbon or a pink pipe cleaner for tail. Place pigs face down until dry. Completed pigs will be able to stand on their own.
