Funeral Arrangements for Austin Police Officer Anthony Martin

Abilene, Texas – Senior Austin Police Officer Anthony “Tony” Martin, who died from injuries sustained in a tragic crash, will be remembered and honored in Abilene on Tuesday, October 4, 2022.

Prior to beginning his career with the Austin Police Department in 2006, Officer Martin honorably served in the United States Air Force, where he was a member of the Abilene and Dyess community for many years. Officer Martin is survived by his parents, wife, three children, and one granddaughter.

The internment, with Military Honors, will be held at the Texas State Veterans Cemetery in Abilene on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at 1 p.m. The public is encouraged to safely line the procession route at 12 p.m. to show their support.

Begin in the 1700 block of E South 11th St. near Expo Dr. (Expo Center of Taylor County)
Continue west on E South 11th St. towards S Judge Ely Blvd.
Turn right on S Judge Ely Blvd. and continue north
Turn left on E Ambler Ave. and continue west
Turn right on W Lake Rd. and continue north
Enter Texas State Veterans Cemetery at 7457 W Lake Rd.
