Fatal Crash in South Abilene – Mockingbird

Abilene, Texas – A crash in South Abilene claimed the life of one individual.

On Thursday, September 8, at approximately 7:45 a.m., the Abilene Police Department responded to a major motor vehicle collision at the intersection of South 7th Street and South Mockingbird Lane.

A bicyclist was traveling west in the 2800 block of South 7th Street. A 2015 Chevrolet Silverado was traveling east in the 2900 block of South 7th Street, and attempted to turn north onto South Mockingbird Lane, colliding with the cyclist in the intersection.

The driver and lone occupant of the Silverado, a 16-year-old male, was not injured.

The cyclist, a 52-year-old female, was transported to the hospital in critical condition. On September 19, next of kin notified the Traffic Division that the cyclist succumbed to her injuries while at the hospital. The cyclist has been identified as Victoria Revilla of Abilene.

Alcohol is not believed to be a factor in the crash at this time. The crash remains under investigation.
