Driver of Vehicle Who Led Law Enforcement on High-speed Chase Arrested

Abilene, Texas – The Abilene Police Department’s Surveillance, Apprehension and Tactics Team (S.A.T.T.) and Agents with the Texas Department of Public Safety arrested a 32-year-old Abilene man after days earlier he led law enforcement on a high-speed chase.

On Friday, February 3, the Tye Police Department and Taylor County Sheriff’s Office were in pursuit of a white Ford pickup. The driver, identified as Roberto Urias, eluded law enforcement. The Abilene Police Department assisted with the follow up investigation and located Mr. Urias on Wednesday, February 9th. He was arrested at a motel located at 1702 E. Overland Trail in North Abilene.

Mr. Urias was transported to the Taylor County Jail and is charged with First Degree Felony Aggravated Assault Against a Public Servant warrant and a Third Degree Possession of a Controlled Substance charge. His bonds total \$1,007,500. He also has a Federal Hold that will keep him behind bars without bond.

44-year-old Juanita Rentschler who was with Urias at the time of his arrest, was charged with Third Degree Felony Hindering Apprehension.

Both remain at the Taylor County Jail.
