68-A Inspections

Detectives from the Abilene Police Department's Auto Theft Task Force will conduct 68-A inspections for residents of the State of Texas.

VIN Verification Information

If you are bringing your vehicle from another state, importing it into the United States or you are attempting to register a vehicle with a lost title, your vehicle must pass a Texas Vehicle Safety Inspection and visual verification of the vehicle identification number (VIN).

Trailer Inspections

If you are registering a trailer because it is homemade, from another state, being imported into the United States or has a lost title, citizens are required by state law to have the trailer inspected by a law enforcement agency prior to registration. If the trailer is homemade, you must bring all receipts of material used for the construction or bill of sale if the trailer was purchased. All trailers brought in for inspections must comply with all state laws including safety chains, lights, registrations or temporary registrations.

You must bring the following documentation:

- Valid Photo ID
- Proof of Ownership
- Proof of Insurance
- Texas Safety Inspection Certification
- Customs Declaration Forms

The department will only accept Cash or Check written to the **City of Abilene**.

Location and Hours of Operation

The inspection will take place every Tuesday morning between 9:00am and Noon.

The location is located at 4565 S 1st St. on the west side of the Abilene Police Department.

Citizens must park in the 200 block of S. San Jose next to the curb outside the gate and wait for the officer to escort them inside the fenced area.

An appointment is necessary for these inspections. Appointments may be made through The Texas Department of Motor Vehicle at (325) 674-1000.
