Florida Man Arrested at Abilene Motel on Forgery and Fraud Charges

ABILENE, TX – 60 year old Duane Noon of Florida was arrested on Thursday, July 26, at a north Abilene Motel after the Abilene Police Department's Fraud unit executed a search and arrest warrant. Abilene Police had been working a Fraud investigation in conjunction with the Orange County Sheriff's Department in Florida.

During the execution of the search and arrest warrant detectives recovered numerous counterfeit drivers licenses and counterfeit credit cards along with thousands of dollars in electronic equipment purchased with fraudulent credit cards in Noon's possession.

Noon was taken into custody without incident. He is charged with First Degree Felony Fraudulent Possession/ Use of Identifying Information over 50 items and 5 counts of Third Degree Felony Forgery of a Government Document. This is still an ongoing investigation that could lead to additional charges being filed.

Duane Noon is currently being held at the Taylor County Jail with bonds totaling \$600,000.
