Counterfeit Money Arrests

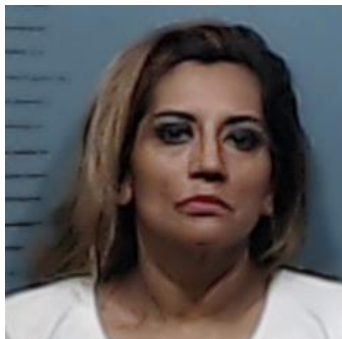
The Abilene Police Department’s Criminal Investigations Division and Patrol Divisions executed a search and arrest warrant stemming from the arrest of Jennifer Carrion for Identity Theft and Forgery.

Two persons were arrested in reference to the search warrant being executed in the 300 block of North 14th Street.

Audrey Adams was arrested for Forgery of Counterfeit Money 3F, Possession with Intent to Deliver Methamphetamine 2F, Possession of Heroin SJF, Forgery of a Financial Instrument SJF, and Possession of Marijuana BM.

Raul Flores was arrested for Forgery of Counterfeit Money 3F, Evading Arrest BM, and outstanding Probation Warrant for Aggravated Assault. Flores attempted to evade officers as they made entry into the home. He was apprehended after a brief foot pursuit.

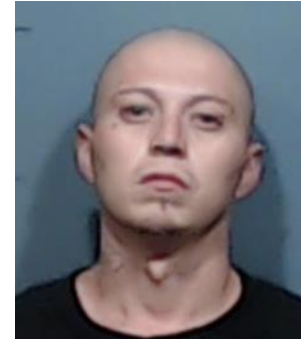
Evidence located during this investigation consists of several pieces of identifying information, counterfeit money, a printer used to produce the counterfeit money, marijuana, heroin and methamphetamine. Jennifer Carrion, Audrey Adams, and Raul Flores are in custody at the Taylor County Jail as a result of this investigation.
