ABILENE, TX – On behalf of the men and women of the Abilene Police Department, we extend our sincere appreciation and gratitude for the support shown by our community in this difficult time.

Detective Elise Ybarra's impact on our Department, the Abilene Community, and the Police Department in Sedalia, Missouri, is evidenced by all the thoughts and prayers expressed by so many. The men and women of both police departments will miss her.

Funeral arrangements for Detective Ybarra are as follows:

Friday, August 11th, at 10 a.m.  
Beltway Park Church, 4009 Beltway South

At the family's direction, Detective Ybarra's remains will be cremated, therefore there will be no visitation, no traditional police funeral procession, and no graveside services.

The family will be escorted to the service by the Abilene Police Department's Traffic Division, to include police motorcycles and marked units. The escort will begin at 9:00 am. We welcome our citizens to join us in a show of support and honor the family by lining the escort route to the service.

The route will be as follows:

Beginning at South 14<sup>th</sup> and Sylvan, the escort will drive west on South 14<sup>th</sup>, through Texas Avenue to the intersection of Highway 277 South and Dub Wright Blvd. The procession will then drive south on Dub Wright to the intersection to Rebecca Lane and Buffalo Gap Rd. The route will turn south on Buffalo Gap Rd at Rebecca and travel south to Beltway South. The escort will then turn east on Beltway South and proceed to Beltway Park Church.

Marked photos of the route are attached for reference.

The family welcomes members of our community to attend the service, but respectfully request that everyone refrain from recording the service. There will be no videotaping allowed inside the church building. Also no photography will be allowed inside the service other than those persons authorized by the family.

After the services are concluded, the family will exit the church and retire to a private location. We welcome all who wish to join us in celebrating the life of Detective Ybarra.

If you choose to line the escort route to Beltway Park Church, safety is paramount. Please park in a safe location and remain off the roadway.
