Police Seeking Victims of Fraud

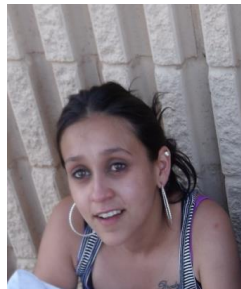
ABILENE, TX – On Friday, March 17, 2017, the Abilene Police Department was called out to a parking lot at a south Abilene shopping center area for a disturbance between two couples. Upon arrival, a check welfare was discovered on a small child with one of the couples, Moses Miguel and Shelly Jon John.

While conducting the welfare check, the Fraud Unit was called out to assist. The male and female were possibly traveling scammers. When members of the fraud unit arrived, they discovered the two had perpetrated a vehicle repair scam on two elderly individuals in a south side shopping center of nearly \$700. The two promised to do a repair(s) for the victims for a sum of cash and never performed any service although they were given money.

This case is being worked as an Exploitation of the Elderly and will be forwarded to the District Attorney's Office when complete. The Abilene Police Department is asking anyone who may have been victimized by these two, to contact Detective Gabe Thompson of the Fraud Unit, 676-6616. Further charges are pending the investigation.
